What to Bring:

- * Bible & Pen(s) no cell phone use as Bibles during our time at camp. If your student does not have a Bible, there will be some Bibles provided up at camp, but if they own their own, they should bring it!
- * Bathing Suit & beach towel Girls suits should be one piece or modest tankini and need to wear BOARD SHORTS.
- * Sweatshirt (evenings can get a little chilly)
- * Shorts & t-shirts The weather will be in the 80's while we are there.
- * Shoes & Socks (several pairs)
- * Pajamas
- * Pillow and sleeping bag (put in a large trash bag, and put an extra trash bag in your camper's suitcase for the way home)

* You may also want to send a sheet or a light blanket with your camper, because it can be warm in the cabin at night & they might prefer to sleep on top of their sleeping bag with the sheet or light blanket.

Medications - if needed

PLEASE NOTE: They must be in their original pharmacy container, along with written instructions, all in a Ziploc plastic bag with camper's name printed on it.

Air soft guns or any other weapons
