

Euthanasia

A. Definitions

```
(Greek) "eu" = good
+ "thamas" = death
```

- AKA: "Right to Die" / Mercy Killings
- "Euthanasia" = Murder to avoid pain or disgrace
 - -- intentional / can be passive or active
 - -- assisted / or unassisted



Judges 9:52-54

And Abimelech came to the tower and fought against it and drew near to the door of the tower to burn it with fire. And a certain woman threw an upper millstone on Abimelech's head and crushed his skull. Then he called quickly to the young man his armorbearer and said to him, "Draw your sword and kill me, lest they say of me, 'A woman killed him.' "And his young man thrust him through, and he died.

1 Samuel 31:3-4

The battle pressed hard against Saul, and the archers found him, and he was badly wounded by the archers. Then Saul said to his armor-bearer, "Draw your sword, and thrust me through with it, lest these uncircumcised come and thrust me through, and mistreat me." But his armorbearer would not, for he feared greatly. Therefore Saul took his own sword and fell upon it.
