*2 Cor. 12:14 Here for the third time I am ready to come to you. And I will not be a burden, for I seek not what is yours but you. For children are not obligated to save up for their parents, but parents for their children. 15 I will most gladly spend and be spent for your souls. If I love you more, am I to be loved less? 16 But granting that I myself did not burden you, I was crafty, you say, and got the better of you by deceit. 17 Did I take advantage of you through any of those whom I sent to you? 18 I urged Titus to go, and sent the brother with him. Did Titus take advantage of you? Did we not act in the same spirit? Did we not take the same steps? (ESV)*

# Application Questions

1. Read **Luke 9:23-24**. Self-preservation feels instinctively reasonable, even wise. What does it look like in daily life when a Christian genuinely rejects that temptation and chooses self-sacrifice instead?
2. Read **Philippians 2:3-4**. God defines love as counting others more significant than yourself. How does our culture redefine love in ways that are essentially the polar opposite of what is described here?
3. Read **Colossians 1:24-26**. Paul rejoiced in suffering for the sake of making Christ fully known. What specific person or opportunity have you been avoiding because the cost felt too high?
4. Read **Proverbs 13:20**. Your closest companions are either pushing you toward sacrificial ministry or steering you toward self-preservation. Which direction is your inner circle currently moving you and what needs to change?
5. Read **Romans 16:3-4**. Prisca and Aquila risked their lives for Paul and the ministry. Who in your life is serving others at real personal cost, and what specific gratitude do they deserve to hear from you?
