1. Read **Hebrews 10:24-25**. What does this passage say should be happening among Christians that can't be done by slipping in the back row on the weekend? What is lost when a Christian attends but never connects?
2. Read **Ephesians 4:1-3**. Obviously, effort is involved in maintaining our unity as we saw in 2 Corinthians 13. Which of these qualities in Ephesians 4:1-3 would cost you the most to practice this week?
3. Read **Philippians 4:4**. If you realized on the way to church that you were negative, distracted, or discouraged, what could you pray about and think about in order to obey the command to rejoice?
4. Read **1 Thessalonians 5:11**. Most Christians intend to encourage others far more than they actually do. What stops you? Is it not knowing what to say, fear, or simply not seeing the need? What would change that this week?
5. Read **1 John 3:18**. Who in your church could benefit from a concrete expression of your love and care this week, and what could you do?
