1 Corinthians 15:35
But someone will ask, "How are the dead raised? With what kind of body do they come?"
36 *You foolish person! What you sow does not come to life unless it dies.*
37 *And what you sow is not the body that is to be, but a bare kernel, perhaps of wheat or of some other grain.* **38** *But God gives it a body as he has chosen, and to each kind of seed its own body.*
39 *For not all flesh is the same, but there is one kind for humans, another for animals, another for birds, and another for fish.* **40** *There are heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the glory of the heavenly is of one kind, and the glory of the earthly is of another.*
41 *There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for star differs from star in glory.* **42** *So is it with the resurrection of the dead. What is sown is perishable; what is raised is imperishable.* **43** *It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness; it is raised in power.* **44** *It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body.*
45 *Thus it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being"; the last Adam became a life-giving spirit.* **46** *But it is not the spiritual that is first but the natural, and then the spiritual.* **47** *The first man was from the earth, a man of dust; the second man is from heaven.* **48** *As was the man of dust, so also are those who are of the dust, and as is the man of heaven, so also are those who are of heaven. (ESV)*
